NCFE Level 3 Certificate in Cyber Security Practices

Want to work in an industry that's currently in demand?* The NCFE Level 3 Certificate in Cyber Security Practices can help you do just that!

WHAT IS THE COURSE ABOUT?

This course will allow you to increase your knowledge and skills about cyber security. It will equip you with in-depth knowledge of cyber security practices that you can use practically in the workplace.

WHO IS IT FOR?

Anyone interested in working in cyber security or IT. Work or industry experience is not required for this course, however you may find it helpful if you have already completed Level 2 in cyber security.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

The course is free as long as you meet the following requirements:

- Aged 19+ and are either:
 - Unemployed
 - Employed
- Live in Birmingham, Black Country, Coventry or Solihull
- Must meet UK residency criteria

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CAREER DEVELOPMENT

This course could lead to jobs such as Cloud Administrator, IT Support Technician or Cyber Security Analyst. The current starting salary in the UK for Cyber Security jobs is £25,000-£35,000 per annum** (www.prospects.ac.uk).

You could continue with further study after this course to progress in a cyber security career. Choose from Level 4 Diploma in Cyber Security, Level 4 Certificate for IT Professional, Level 4 Certificate in Information and Cyber Security Foundations or Level 4 Certificate in Cyber Security and Intrusion for Business. This could lead to a yearly salary of £47,499*** (www.cwjobs.co.uk).

HOW IS IT TAUGHT?

- There are 6 mandatory units for the course
- All teaching is online self-study
- You will have access to a dedicated skills coach
- Weekly 1-2-1 technical support

Complete the course over a flexible duration (maximum of 12 weeks).

- Applying cyber security control
- Incident response plans and reviews
- How to reduce and remove vulnerability to cyber attacks
- Skills and behaviours required for cyber security
